



TWIST POS System offers M.2 Solid State Drive (SSD).


\*Please note that if you are replacing your SSD, you will need to reinstall your operating system after replacing it.


### 3.3 Install the Power Adapter

The system is equipped with a 65W power adapter. Please follow below procedures to get it plugged into the system.

1. Slide out the Cable Cover of the I/O Module.



2. Remove the two side-screws to release the I/O Module.



- 3. Locate the DC-IN Jack and connect the power cable properly.
- 4. Secure the I/O Module with the two side-screws and slide in the Cable Cover.




